Petitioner has approached this Court for grant of regular bail by filing this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, in FIR No.25, dated 26.06.2020, registered at Women Police Station Hansi, District Hisar, under Sections 341, 354-C, 452, 506, 376(2)(n) of the Indian Penal Code and Section 6 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012, where the petitioner has been arrested on 02.07.2020.

The case has been taken up for hearing on various dates and the endeavour on the part of this Court had been that the material prosecution witnesses are examined. The prosecutrix and her mother have been examined and the father of the prosecutrix has been given up. The remaining four witnesses are all officials with that being in mind and
