The petitioner has filed this petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order dated 18.01.2021 (Annexure P-8) passed by respondent No.2 in response to the legal notice dated 02.12.2020 (Annexure P-7) vide which the claim of the petitioner, for consideration of the appointment against vacant post, has been declined; along with certain other prayers.

A perusal of the impugned order shows that the respondents have clarified in the reply that although one vacancy had remained vacant in the category of Physically Handicapped, however, before the result of the previous recruitment was declared, the second recruitment had already been initiated by issuing the advertisement. Therefore, there was no reason or occasion for them to anticipate that one vacancy would be

left vacant in the previous recruitment; and to include the same in the second recruitment. It has also not been disputed by the counsel for the petitioner that no subsequent recruitment has been initiated by the respondents after above said second recruitment.

In view of the above, the counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition, with liberty to the petitioner to raise his grievance at an appropriate stage, if the need be, but in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn, with liberty as aforesaid.
