As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellants as well as counsel for the Insurance Company, separately recorded, a sum of Rs.2,25,000/- over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal, is awarded to all the appellants in full & final satisfaction of the claim.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company Limited to deposit three cheques, one in the sum of Rs.1,25,000/- favouring claimant No.3 – Chameli and two cheques in the sum of Rs.50,000/- each favouring claimants 1 and 2 with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 23.12.2022. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellants' counsel may collect the cheques/drafts from the office of the Lok Adalat. The office shall retain the photocopies of the cheques/drafts bearing signatures of the Counsel.

Appeal stands disposed of.
