Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.123 dated 17.06.2021, under Sections 498-A and 406 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Civil Lines Batala, District Gurdaspur.

Vide order dated 26.07.2021 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 26.07.2021, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute. He has further submitted that the parties appeared before the Mediation Centre also and the matter is amicably resolved.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 has opposed the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Hardip Singh, affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for further investigation.

In view of the above, interim order dated 26.07.2021 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
