Petition herein, *inter alia*, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondent-Commission to consider the petitioner's candidature for the post of Deputy Ranger (Category No.11), claiming that he is eligible for the same as per qualifications laid down in the Advertisement dated 10.12.2015 (Annexure P-1).

2. Petitioner applied for the post in question under General Category. He cleared the written examination and Physical Measurement Test as well as Physical Screening Test, but as per the impugned notice/result dated 30.04.2019 (Annexure P-4), name of the petitioner did not figure in it for interview. Hence, the present petition.

3. On 05.05.2022, result of the petitioner was brought in a sealed cover and taken on record as Annexure 'A'. He has obtained 166 marks in written examination and 10 marks in viva-voce making aggregate of 176 marks as against the last selected candidate having obtained 189 marks, no further grounds are made out to keep the writ proceedings pending.

4. In the premise, it seems that being unaware of his actual result, the petitioner was misled into filing the instant petition. However, he has actually scored 176 aggregate marks, as aforesaid. Result of the petitioner is not under challenge before this Court.

5. Writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to challenge his result, if so advised.
