This is a petition seeking regular bail in case of FIR No.318 dated 17.10.2018 under Sections 323, 34, 341, 365, 506 IPC, 1860 and 25 of Arms Act 1959, registered at Police Station Sadar Narnaul District Mahendergarh.

In the heading of petition it is stated to be first petition for regular bail. In para-16 of the petition, it is specifically pleaded that no similar petition was earlier filed either before this Court or before the Supreme Court. Office has annexed a report, stating that by matching the FIR number from the record, it is revealed that this is second petition and earlier CRM-M-10258 of 2021 was dismissed by this Court.

From the perusal of the order passed in CRM-M-10258 of 2021, dated 12.3.2021, it is forth coming that learned State counsel made a statement that prosecution witnesses have already been examined and the matter is fixed for final arguments. In view of statement made, the petition was not pressed.

This petition has been filed by changing the counsel withholding the said fact stating the petition as first petition. The conduct of the petitioner is deprecated.

The petition is dismissed with costs of Rs.5000/- to be deposited with the Poor Patient Welfare Fund of PGIMER, Chandigarh.

Since the main case has been dismissed, the pending application, if any is rendered infructuous.
