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DEEPAK SIBAL, J. (Oral)

The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 97 dated 27.07.2020 registered under Sections 363 and 366 IPC at Police Station Alewa, district Jind.

Through the impugned FIR the petitioner is sought to be prosecuted for the alleged abduction of the complainant's daughter.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no case is made out against the petitioner as the complainant's daughter, the alleged victim is an adult; she had gone with the petitioner on her own and that she has ever since been living happily with him.

Learned counsel appearing for the alleged victim admits to the afore assertions.

Learned State counsel also does not dispute the above factual position and rather adds that as per the investigations done by the police the complainant/the victim's father has also accepted the relationship between the victim and the petitioner and that in the light of these developments the police has prepared a report to cancel the impugned FIR.

In the light of the afore facts, continuation of the proceedings in pursuance of the afore-referred FIR would be an abuse of the process of law and this Court deems it just and proper to allow the petition and resultantly quash FIR No. 97 dated 27.07.2020 registered under Sections 363 and 366 IPC at Police Station Alewa, district Jind and all proceedings arising therefrom qua the petitioner.
