This is a petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to respondent No.3 to hand over the custody of minor daughter of the petitioner, namely, Simranjit Kaur and further issuance of direction to respondent No.3 and to respondent No.1 to give proper protection to Simranjit Kaur and not allow respondent No.4 i.e. Jaspreet Singh @ Jaswinder Singh @ Jassu, to contact the daughter of the petitioner.

On 26.11.2021, following order was passed:-

“Reply dated 26.11.2021 along with Annexures R-4/1 and R-4/2 filed on behalf of respondent No.4 is taken on record.

Ms. Simranjit Kaur (minor) has narrated in categorical terms that she does not want to go to her parental home as she is apprehending that her parents would get her married despite the fact that she is minor. She further submits that she wants to stay at Ashiana, Sector-15, Chandigarh, for the time being.

Adjourned to 15.02.2022.”

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that Ms. Simranjit Kaur, has now attained majority and wishes to stay with her parents and in view of the order dated 30.03.2022 passed in CRWP-6183-2021 filed by Simranjit Kaur, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Learned counsel for the respondent(s) does not dispute the above said fact.

In view of the above, the present petition has become infructuous and the same is disposed of, accordingly.
