CRM-M-29102-2021

Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.386 dated 01.07.2021, under Sections 313, 406, 498-A, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Zirakpur, District SAS Nagar (Mohali).

Vide order dated 28.09.2021 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 28.09.2021, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such her interim bail may be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Nathi Ram, affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and she is no more required for further investigation.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 has vehemently opposed the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the above, interim order dated 28.09.2021 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
