Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to transfer the investigation of FIR No.87 dated 15.05.2014 under Sections 302/34 IPC, registered at Police Station City Jagraon, District Ludhiana Rural, to CBI.

In pursuance of the order dated 03.08.2017, vide which the investigation was transferred to CBI, learned counsel for respondent No.4-CBI has placed on record copies of the orders dated 07.03.2022 and 11.03.2022 passed by the Special Judicial Magistrate, CBI, Punjab, Mohali, to submit that CBI has submitted a closure report and petitioner No.1-complainant has stated that he has no objection if the closure report is

accepted by the Court. In this regard, separate statement of petitioner No.2- another complainant Neetu Gupta has already been recorded, in which she has also stated that she has no objection if the closure report is submitted by the CBI.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that this petition may be disposed of having been rendered as infructuous.
