The present application has been filed for disposal of the writ petition having been rendered infructuous.

Counsel for the applicant-petitioners has submitted that the necessary appointment as such as Constable has been granted to respondent No.1 vide order dated 11.01.2022 by the Director General of Police, U.T., Chandigarh. The relief granted by the Tribunal vide order dated 03.12.2019 (Annexure P-1) was for reconsideration of the case of the applicant therein as such of appointment as Constable. Accordingly, the writ petition is disposed of having been rendered infructuous.

It is apparent that the necessary relief has been granted as such to the said respondent. However, office report would go on to show that respondent No.1 has not been served.

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Keeping in view the above, we do not propose to issue notice to him since the writ petition itself has been rendered infructuous.

Accordingly, the application is allowed.

CWP No. 13203 of 2020

In view of the above, the writ petition is disposed of having been rendered infructuous. It is, however, open for the respondent to agitate in case he is not satisfied with the order dated 11.01.2022 which is conditional regarding seniority or arrears of pay etc. in accordance with law.
