Present petition is under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for seeking anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.20 dated 09.05.2022, registered under Sections 498-A and 34 IPC, 1860 registered at Police Station Dorangla, District Gurdaspur.

On 07.06.2022, the following order was passed:-

“ *Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.20 dated 09.05.2022 under Sections 498-A and 34 IPC registered at Police Station Dorangla, District Gurdaspur.*

Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that the FIR in question which has been got registered by his wife is totally vague and on the face of it fabricated allegations levelled against him as well as his mother. He submits that it was on account of some minor and trivial disputes between the petitioner and his wife i.e. the complainant, the FIR in question came to be registered. He also submits that the petitioner is still willing to reconcile all his differences with his wife i.e. the complainant and which is precisely the reason that he has also filed a petition under

Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955.

Meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation and appear before the investigating agency as and when called upon to do so. In the event of his arrest, he shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall abide by the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in pursuance of interim directions, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

On instructions from ASI Gurnam Singh, learned State counsel states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the aforesaid submissions, the order dated 07.06.2022 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition is allowed.
