This is a criminal writ petition that has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking direction to respondents No.2 to 4 not to harass the petitioner and her family members and to protect their life and liberty.

It is contended that her husband Sonu Bhatti was involved in an FIR No.192, dated 18.06.2020, under Sections 307, 452, 506, 148, 149 of IPC, 1860 and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station City Ferozepur, District Ferozepur, with the allegation that the petitioner's husband and other co-accused had tried to commit the murder of the complainant by firing at him. It is submitted that the police were continuously harassing the petitioner and her family members despite her

informing the police that her husband was not residing there and had run away.

Notice of motion was issued in the said matter to which appearance has been caused by the respondent-State. Ms. Rashmi Attri, AAG, Punjab, who is present through the medium of video conferencing, on instruction from ASI Roop Singh, would submit that the FIR had been registered against the husband of the petitioner and other accused persons under Section 307 IPC, however, he has since passed away. It is submitted that the petitioner herein is not required in any matter whatsoever and her presence would not be required at the police station.

In view of the statement made, counsel for the petitioner does not press the instant petition and the same is dismissed accordingly.
