The petitioners herein seek the quashing of the FIR bearing No.716 dated 12.11.2021 registered at Police Station Sector-10, District Gurugram, under Sections 420, 120-B, 467, 468 and 471 IPC and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

Mr. Apoorv Garg, learned Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, has appeared on behalf of respondent No.1 in this case in pursuance of the copy of the instant petition having been sent to the respondent-State in advance and on the instructions from ASI Pawan Kumar, Economic Offences Wing (II), Gurugram, he apprises the Court that the investigation in the criminal case, arising out of the subject FIR, is still going on and has not yet been concluded.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks

permission to withdraw the instant petition while submitting that the petitioners would be moving a fresh petition for seeking the quashing of the above-said FIR at the appropriate stage, i.e after the conclusion of the investigation proceedings.

Learned State counsel has no objection for the same.

Resultantly, the petition in hand stands dismissed for having been withdrawn accordingly.
