Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in FIR No.71 dated 10.7.2017 registered under Sections 406, 498-A IPC (later on section 494 I.P.C was added) at Police Station, Women District Patiala.

By virtue of the order dated 17.11.2018 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to the order dated 17.11.2018 petitioner has joined investigation. It is also submitted that the matter has already been settled amicably.

Learned counsel for the complainant has endorsed the fact that mediation proceedings remained successful and parties have settled their dispute amicably.

Learned State counsel has endorsed the same and submitted that petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the order dated 17.11.2018 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C and the petition stands allowed.
