The instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., is filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.99, dated 28.04.2022, under Sections 420, 506 and 120-B of the IPC, registered at Police Station Shahkot, District Jalandhar.

This Court granted the interim protection vide order dated 08.06.2022, prima facie observing that the dispute involved in the present case is civil in nature being contractual obligation arising out of family loan.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of order dated 08.06.2022, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Daljit Singh, submits that the amount of Rs.6,40,000/- has already been recovered after the petitioner joined the investigation in pursuant to the order dated 08.06.2022.

A perusal of the FIR clearly depicts that it is a case of civil nature, wherein the breach of contract has taken place and the remedy available is either for filing suit for recovery or for specific performance as

is evident from the totality of the facts as examined by this Court.

In view of the above, the order dated 08.06.2022 is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of.
