The petitioner union has approached this court impugning the orders/circulars dated 26.5.2022 and 27.5.2022 (Annexures P-1 and P-2) whereby the data of employees of the Sangrur Central Cooperative Bank has been called for the purpose of assigning them election duty, which is scheduled to be held on 23.6.2022.

On the last date of hearing learned counsel for the petitioner union had prayed for time to seek instructions regarding the stand taken by counsel for the respondents.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Namit Kumar, Advocate, who is already appearing in this case, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

We have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the records.

Though, learned counsel for the petitioner union has shown the representation filed before the concerned authority, however, the same is

not the part of the present writ petition.

Learned counsel for the respondent candidly submits that in case the petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider this petition itself as a representation on behalf of the petitioner union, the respondents would deal with the same in accordance with law before the date fixed in the elections.

In view of the above, present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent authorities to treat this petition itself as a representation and deal with the grievances raised by petitioner union strictly in accordance with law by 20.6.2022.
