This petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for directing the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family, which is in danger at the hands of gangsters by providing adequate security and also to restore the police protection/security provided to the petitioner and with a further prayer to grant permission to the petitioner to convert his private vehicle into a bullet proof vehicle at his own costs.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has inter alia submitted that at present, the petitioner is the President of Punjab Chapter of National Students' Union of India (NSUI) the Student Wing Organization of Indian National Congress (INC) and is being issued threat by a gangster. He submits that he has already filed representations (Annexures P-5 and 6) before respondent No.3, however, no action has been taken till date.

Notice of motion.

On asking of this Court, Ms. Sakshi Bakshi, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State.

Without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, I dispose of the petition with directions to respondent No. 3 i.e. the Additional Director General of Police, Security, Punjab to look into the representations of the petitioner, Annexures P-5 and P-6 and decide the same as per law within a period of one month from today.
