The petitioner prays for pre-arrest bail in a criminal case arising from FIR No.5, dated 11.03.2022, registered under Sections 7, 13 of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988, at Police Station State Vigilance Bureau, Rohtak.

As per the case of the prosecution, the first informant Dharmender ordered 4 tyres from Ujjwal Sharma. On being brought, they were found defective. The parties entered into a dispute and went to the Police Post. The petitioner got the matter compromised and directed Ujjwal to take away two defective tyres and remaining two tyres were left with the first informant. When he tried to go along with the remaining two tyres, the petitioner demanded Rs.9,000/- which were later on settled for Rs.5,000/-. On trap being laid, Constable Neeraj, who was working with the accused, was arrested with tainted money of Rs.5,000/-.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, no ground to grant concession of anticipatory bail is made out.

Dismissed.
