JASJIT SINGH BEDI, J. (ORAL)

The prayer in the present petition is for the issuance of directions especially in the nature of mandamus for directing the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the helpless petitioners, who is in dangerous hands of respondent Nos.5 to 7, who are repeatedly extending threats to eliminate petitioner Nos.1 and 2.

The learned State counsel has filed a reply dated 10.09.2021. Paras 4 and 5 of the reply read as under:-

“4.That during the course of investigation statement of complainant has been record and relevant record is being collected. Presently the case is under investigation and further action will be taken

accordingly, as per provision of law after completion of the investigation.

5. That on 10.09.2021, statement of the petitioner Manpreet Kaur Saini was recorded. She stated that after registration of the case, no threat has been received by her. If in future, any threat is to be received by her, she will inform to the police accordingly. From the statement of the petitioner Manpreet Kaur, presently there is no danger to the life and liberty of the petitioners. However, police is keeping watch at the residence of the petitioners.”

A perusal of the aforementioned paragraphs would show that as of now the petitioner No.1-Manpreet Kaur Saini wife of Yajuvinder Saini does not face any threat to her life. She in fact, categorically states that in case there is a threat in future, she will inform the police accordingly.

In this view of the matter, no further orders are called for by this Court.
