The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in FIR No.71 dated 5.4.2022 registered under Sections 363, 366-A IPC at Police Station City Kapurthala, District Kapurthala.

By virtue of the order dated 9.6.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.
