This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C for issuance of directions to the official respondents to conduct a fair and impartial investigation by a senior police officer with respect to the cross case got registered by the petitioner bearing DDR No.21 dated 12.11.2017 under Sections 323/324/427/148/149 IPC at Police Station Bhindi Saidan, District Amritsar Rural as Sections 307/452/354 IPC and Arms Act have not been added since the local police is helping the accused who are highly influential and political connected.

The learned State counsel has referred to the reply dated 28.05.2019. As per para-7 of the said reply, cross version DDR No.21 dated 12.11.2017 under Sections 323, 324, 427, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Bhindi Saidan, Amritsar-Rural has been found to be false and the injuries alleged to be sustained by the petitioner have been found to be doubtful, unlikely and highly improbable to have been caused as a result of discharge

of firearm as alleged by the petitioner.

The learned State counsel submits that in terms of the reply, a cancellation report has been submitted to the Illaqa Magistrate on 16.03.2020 which is still pending adjudication.

Be that as it may, in view of the reply, this petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to avail his alternative remedies in accordance with law.
