For the reasons enumerated in the application, the same is allowed and the amended memo of parties appended with the application is taken on record.

The present writ petition has been filed on the apprehension that the petitioner and her husband are being harassed by respondent Nos. 3 and 4.

Learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State have been heard.

Learned counsel for the State submits that as per General Diary Details, there is an FIR No.450 dated 2.10.2020 registered under Sections 198, 201, 420, 467, 468, 471, 474, 120-B IPC, Section 12(1)b of Passport Act, Sections 66C, 66D of IT Act at Police Station City Tohana, against the

husband of the petitioner. He further submits that the respondents have no intention to harass the petitioner.

In this view of the matter, the statement of the counsel for the State is place on record and the petitioner and her husband are granted leave to avail other remedy in respect of the General Dairy Details referred to supra.

Disposed of accordingly.
