Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case FIR No.53, dated 13.5.2022, registered under Sections 498-A, 406 IPC, at Police Station Joga, District Mansa.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.
