Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.92 dated 02.03.2022 under Sections 406, 498-A, 323, 506 IPC and Section 3 of the SC/ST Act, registered at Police Station Parao.

By virtue of the order dated 13.06.2022, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from DSP Ram Kumar has endorsed the same and submitted that petitioner is no more required for further investigation.
