AVNEESH JHINGAN , J.(Oral)

1. This petition was filed for an emergency parole under Section 3(1) (a) of Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners Act, 1988(for short 'the Act'). The parole was sought on the medical ground. On 18th November, 2021, the petitioner was ordered to be released for a period of two months. Thereafter, the parole was extended from time to time.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner on 4th April, 2022 stated that petitioner has been advised for Liver Transplant. On 31st August, 2022, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that petitioner is admitted in Rajender Hospital, Patiala and he is suffering from Cirrhosis of Liver and there are complications with regard to the Kidney. CRM has been filed annexing the medical record. The medical position of the petitioner is not forthcoming from annexures.

3. There is no dispute with regard to the fact that conviction of the petitioner was upheld by the Supreme Court.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that an application

has been moved to the Governor, State of Haryana for premature release on

the basis of medical condition.

5. Learned State counsel submits that the parole is statutory relief and it cannot be claimed as a matter of right and extended indefinitely.
6. Without commenting upon the merits of the case, considering that there is a medical issue with the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to avail remedies in accordance with law. However, parole granted is extended for four weeks to give time to the petitioner to avail remedies in accordance with law.
7. Since the main petition is disposed of, pending application is also disposed of.
