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**AVNEESH JHINGAN , J.(Oral)**

This petition was filed seeking directions to the official respondents to take appropriate action, conduct proper investigation and enquiry regarding the mysterious death of petitioner's son namely corporal (in Air Force) Harpreet Singh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner after arguing for some time and realising that as per the contents of para 3 of Annexure P-4, the request for an investigation by a suitable agency including CBI was sent to Chief Secretary, Govt. of UP, seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law.

The relevant portion of para 3 of Annexure P-4 is reproduced below:-

*“Further, the subject of investigation of crimes is within the domain of the State of Govt. Since the subject matter is under their investigation, the government of UP has been requested for considering your request in the above representation, for investigation by a suitable agency including CBI as deemed appropriate by the State Govt. a*

*copy of the communication addressed to the chief Secretary, Govt. of U.P. is enclosed herewith.”*

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.

Since the main petition is dismissed as withdrawn, pending application, if any, is disposed of.
