The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.537 dated 06.05.2016 registered under Sections 323, 341, 354(D) and 509 IPC at Police Station City, Panipat on the basis of compromise dated 09.04.2019 (Annexure P-3).

On 16.10.2019 this Court had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate within 15 days for recording of their respective statements with regard to the compromise/settlement, who in turn was directed to submit a report along with the recorded statements with regard to the veracity of the compromise, if any, between the parties as also to apprise this Court if there is any other case pending against them and his/their status of being proclaimed offender/person.

As directed, report dated 20.12.2019 from the Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, Panipat, has been received, as per which the parties had recorded their statements before the Trial Court in terms of the compromise arrived at between them.

Learned State counsel has also raised no objection if the present petition is allowed.

In view of the above, continuation of the proceedings in pursuance of the afore-referred FIR in which the offences are not heinous and the matter having been compromised, would be an abuse of the process of law and in terms of the law laid down by the Supreme Court in **Narinder Singh vs. State of Punjab, (2014) 6 SCC 466**, this Court deems it just and proper to allow the petition and resultantly quash the FIR No.537 dated 06.05.2016 registered under Sections 323, 341, 354(D) and 509 IPC at Police Station City, Panipat and all proceedings arising therefrom, qua the petitioner.
