**ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN, J. (Oral)**

Prayer in this petition is for transfer of the petition filed by the respondent-husband under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, titled as ***Manchinder Singh vs. Rajwinder Kaur***, pending before the Family Court, Ludhiana to the competent Court of jurisdiction at Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is residing at Amritsar and she was married to respondent on 26.02.2008 and out of the said wedlock, three children were born, who are of 13, 11 and 09 years of age. It is further submitted that the children are living in the care and custody of the respondent.

The only reason given by the petitioner for leaving the company of the respondent-husband is that he was maltreating her.

Learned counsel for the respondent-husband has raised an objection that since the respondent is maintaining all the three minor children and is taking care of their studies and upbringing, it would be very

difficult for him to attend the proceedings at Amritsar. It is further submitted that the respondent is ready to pay Rs. 500/- per day as travelling expenses to the petitioner-wife in order to enable her to attend the proceedings at Ludhiana.

The aforesaid offer is not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent-husband that as and when, the petitioner is to appear before the Court at Ludhiana, the respondent-husband would pay her Rs. 500/- as travelling expenses, on each and every date.
