The prayer under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail in Cross case registered vide General Diary No.035 dated 08.04.2022 under Sections 307, 452, 427, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25 & 27 of Arms Act registered at Police Station Majitha, District Amritsar Rural arising out of FIR No.26 dated 22.03.2022 under Sections 302, 307, 341`, 436, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25 & 27 of Arms Act registered at Police Station Majitha, District Amritsar Rural.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 13.06.2022 passed by this Court, petitioners have joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel on instructions submits that the petitioners have joined investigation in terms of orders dated 13.06.2022

and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 13.06.2022 is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and they shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
