The prayer in the petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for the issuance of a writ especially in the nature of Mandamus for directing the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner along with his friend Poonam at the hands of private respondents.

The Counsel for the petitioner reiterates the contents of his petition.

However, counsel for the State contends that the Petitioner is not residing at the address mentioned in the petition.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.

Disposed of.

If the Petitioner and his friend Poonam are aggrieved in any manner they are free to move a fresh application for protection which shall be dealt with by the Authorities in accordance with law.
