The present petition has been filed under Section 482
Cr.P.C. with a prayer for the grant of protection to the petitioners.

As per the averments made in the petition, petitioner No.1
was married to respondent No.7 in the year 2016 against her will by her
grand-mother and since the date of marriage husband of the petitioner used
to beat her regularly and always asked her to leave the house and due to
these circumstances, number of times Panchayat was also convened and
therefore, apprehending threat at the hands of private respondents, the
petitioners have filed the present petition for protection

Learned State counsel has submitted that status report has
been filed in the present case and by referring to the same, he has submitted

that present petition was filed by the petitioners on 3.2.2018 in which notice of motion was issued on 6.2.2018 but thereafter, since the petitioners had committed theft and had taken gold jewellery and some cash as per para 3 of the affidavit, they were arrested on 23.2.2018 and thereafter, have been released on bail. He submitted that there is no threat to the petitioners and therefore, the present petition is liable to be dismissed.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners has submitted that, in fact, the matter has since been compromised between the parties and there is no threat perception to the petitioners.

In view of aforesaid position, no cause of action survives in the present petition and consequently, the same is hereby dismissed.
