[1] Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating action against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 14.12.2018 in CWP No.23791 of 2018 in case titled as Ravinder Singh Contractor vs. State of Punjab and Ors.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.23791 of 2018 was disposed of by directing the concerned authority to decide the claim of the petitioner as contained in the legal notice/representation within six weeks from the receipt of certified copy of the order and in case any amount was found due to the petitioner, to release payment to the petitioner after obtaining sanction from the Finance Department if required.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that needful has been done in terms of order, Annexure P/1 dated 14.12.2018 and payment as per entitlement released to the petitioner, therefore, the petitioner

is not interested in pursuing the contempt petition and may be

permitted to withdraw the same.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
