Petitioner is seeking pre-arrest bail in FIR No.40 dt.15.05.2022 under Sections 393, 506, 427, 148 & 149 IPC registered at Police Station Jhunir, District Mansa.

Mr.Karanbir Singh, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent/State.

As per FIR, one Sandeep Kumar and others went to Vashnavi Filling Station of Indian Oil at Village Moda at around 9:00 PM on motorcycles, demanded the salesman/attendant there to give money in the bunk and on failure of the said person to do so, they damaged the machinery in the petrol bunk using baseball bats after they were joined by some others on two other motorcycles. In the CCTV footage, according to the complaint, this incident was recorded.

Having regard to these allegations, I am of the opinion that this is not a fit case for grant of anticipatory Bail.

Petition is accordingly dismissed.
