[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating action against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 03.12.2018 in CWP No.22995 of 2018 in case titled as The Yadwindra Co-operative Labour and Construction Society vs. State of Punjab and Ors.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.22995 of 2018 was disposed of by directing the concerned authority to decide the claim of the petitioner as contained in the legal notice/representation within six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case any amount was found due to the petitioner, payment of the same was ordered to be released to the petitioner after obtaining sanction from the Finance Department, if required.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that needful has been done in terms of order, Annexure P/1 dated 03.12.2018 and

payment as per the entitlement released to the petitioner, therefore, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the contempt petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
