In the petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seek directions to provide protection to the life and liberty from the private respondents No.4 & 5 and their relatives and not to harass or interfere in the peaceful life of the petitioner.

In sum and substance, the grouse of the petitioner is that respondent No.4 is aggrieved against the marriage of her daughter on her own choice and thus, the brother-in-law, respondent No.5 is also threatening the petitioner who is stated to be staying with her mother separately.

Representation dated 07.06.2022 (Annexure P-2) has also been filed with respondents No.2 in this regard.

Mr. A.A. Pathak, Addl.AG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents/State. Copy of the paper-book be supplied to him during the course of the day.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondents No.2 & 3 to look into the above said representation filed by the petitioner and take appropriate action in accordance with law, if so required.
