In the present petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India directions are sought for safeguarding the life and personal liberty at the hands of respondent Nos.6 to 12.

In sum and substance the case of the petitioner is that on account of involvement with Davinder Kaur daughter of respondent No.7 Sukhjinder Singh, he requires the said protection.

It is submitted that on account of forcible marriage with respondent No.6 while she was minor, the issue has arisen. She is at present in the Children Home-Gandhi Vaneeta Ashram, Jalandhar on account of litigation having been initiated by the petitioner (Annexure P-2) and, thus, he is under a threat perception from the private respondents. Representation dated 06.06.2022 (Annexure P-3) is stated to have been filed with respondent No.3.

Notice of motion.

Mr. A.A. Pathak, Addl. AG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents/State.

Keeping in view the above, let respondent No.3 look into the averments made in the said representation and take necessary action, if so required.
