Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking quashing of FIR No.95 dated 04.09.2017, registered for offence under Section 376 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 3 and 4 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012, at Police Station City Fazilka, District Fazilka, Annexure P-1, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of the compromise dated 27.09.2017, Annexure P-2, arrived at between the parties.

Report has been received from the Trial Court that none of the parties have appeared for recording of their statements. Moreover, a perusal of the FIR, Annexure P-1, shows that the petitioner is alleged to have sexually assaulted a minor.

In view of the judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court in *The State of Madhya Pradesh Versus Laxmi Narayan and others 2019 (5) SCC 688*, petition cannot be entertained.

Petition is dismissed.
