This petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.100 dated 26.05.2021 under Sections 387 & 506 IPC, registered at Police Station City Malout, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset, relies upon order dated 27.05.2022 passed in CRM-M-22533-2022, vide which co-accused Raman Bawa has been granted the concession of regular bail by this Court. The operative part of the order reads as under:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset, relies upon order dated 05.05.2022 passed in CRM-M-34536-2021, vide which co-accused Lakhwinder Singh @ Lucky has already been granted the concession of regular bail by this Court. The operative part of the order reads as under:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter has been amicably settled between the parties and vide order of even date

passed in CRM-M-54208-2021, praying for quashing of aforesaid FIR, on the basis of compromise, the parties are directed to appear before the trial Court for recording their statements in support of the compromise. It is further submitted that the petitioner is in custody for the last 11 months and is not involved in any other case.

Learned counsel for the complainant has acknowledged that there is a valid compromise between the parties.

Learned State counsel has filed the custody certificate in the Court today and has not disputed the factum of compromise.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that vide order dated 20.05.2022 passed in CRM-M-21045-2022, another co-accused Gagan Maluja @ Gagan Kumar has also been granted the concession of regular bail by this Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the allegations against the petitioner are identical to that of aforesaid co-accused and the matter stands compromised between the parties.

Learned State counsel, on the basis of the custody certificate filed today in Court, has not disputed the factual position and submitted that *challan* stands presented, however, no PW has been examined so far. As per custody certificate, the petitioner is in judicial custody for the last 01 year and 28 days and he is not involved in any other case.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the instant petition is allowed. The

petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Illaqa Magistrate, concerned.
