In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioners is for finalizing the seniority of the Head Masters, who have been allocated Mewat Cadre so that promotion to the post of Principal could be made keeping in view the Mewat District School Education (Group B) Service Rules, 2012.

Learned counsel for the petitioners argues that a proposal was sent for finalizing the seniority of the Head Masters by the District Education Officer, Nuh vide letter dated 29.06.2021 (Annexure P-10) but the same is still pending consideration with respondent No. 2 and no decision has been taken to finalize the same, which is causing prejudice to the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case, no decision has been taken on letter dated 29.06.2021 (Annexure P-10) so far, appropriate decision with regard to the finalization of the seniority of the Head Masters allocated to Mewat Cadre will be passed within a period of three months of the receipt of copy of this order.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the above, no further grievance of the petitioners survives in the present petition and the same may kindly be disposed of as such.

Ordered accordingly.
