This is an application for grant of leave to file the present petition under previous enrolment number since an objection was raised by the committee during the process of enrolling the counsel.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed as prayed for.

Main case

Prayer in the present petition is for quashing of impugned FIR No.122 dated 24.6.2021, registered under Sections 346 IPC at Police Station Hassanpur, District Palwal alongwith all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case by the respondent-husband. It is also submitted that marriage between the petitioner and respondent No.2 has already been dissolved by decree of divorce on 23.5.2022 under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955. He submits that prosecution of the petitioner is nothing but an abuse of the process of the Court.

He submits that for the same the petitioner has already filed representations
