Main Case

This petition is filed for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.59, dated 21.04.2022, under Section 21 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for brevity 'the Act') (Sections 29 and 27-A of the Act added later on), registered at Police Station Division No.2, District Ludhiana.

This Court vide order dated 13.06.2022, granted the interim bail subject to joining investigation.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurpreet Singh submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is co-operating.

As custody of the petitioner is not needed, the interim bail granted is made absolute.
