Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case F.I.R. No.54 dated 01.05.2022 under Section 307, 323, 341, 506, 148 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Nangal, District Rupnagar.

Vide order dated 13.06.2022, the petitioners were granted the interim protection.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Parveen Kumar, submits that in compliance of the order dated 13.06.2022, the petitioners have already joined the investigation and they are not required for any custodial interrogation.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that on the basis of compromise arrived at between the parties, CRM-M-33157-2022 titled 'Manoj Kumar and others Vs. State of Punjab and another', has been filed for quashing of the FIR in which notice has been issued for 29.09.2022.

The said fact has not been disputed by learned counsel for the complainant.

In view of above, the order dated 13.06.2022 granting interim bail to the petitioners, is made absolute. The petitioners shall abide by the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. in letter and spirit.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
