The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. praying for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 7 dated 10.01.2022 registered under Sections 452, 354, 506, 427, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25, 27 of the Arms Act, P.S. City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

The attribution to the petitioner is that of giving a *dang* blow on the head of Shamsher singh, which hit on the left side of his head. The petitioner is stated to have been accompanied by one Manbir Singh, who was carrying a pistol and had hit the butt to the complainant Baljit Singh on his forehead. Anticipatory bail application of Manbir Singh i.e. CRM-M-18858 of 2022 has been dismissed as not pressed on 05.02.2022, though it has been entertained qua petitioner No.2 namely Sham Singh.

In such circumstances, this Court is of the opinion that the petitioner is also in similar position as Manbir Singh as specific injury has been attributed to him, which has also been noticed by the Additional

Sessions Judge, Tarn Taran. The petitioner is a part of assembly which barged into the house of the complainant at 9.30 P.M. and have assaulted them.

In such circumstances, no case is made out for grant of anticipatory bail and the present petition accordingly stands dismissed.
