This petition under Section 482 of Code of Criminal Procedure is filed seeking quashing of FIR No. 11, dated 3.2.2012, under Sections 452, 341, 323, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 29.1.2020.

Vide order dated 17.12.2020 the parties were directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial court for getting their statements recorded with regard to compromise.

The report dated 24.12.2020 is received from Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Dasuya stating that none of the parties appeared for recording of the statements.
