By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of 'anticipatory bail' under the provisions of Section 438 Cr.P.C., in case FIR No.39, dated 05.02.2022, registered at Police Station Punhana, District Nuh, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 13(1) and 13(3) of the Haryana Gausvansh Sanrakshan and Gausamvardhan Act, 2015.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in compliance of the order dated 15.06.2022, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from the police official who is present in Court, corroborates the said averment and submits that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required and even as per the reply dated 08.08.2022, filed in Court today he could not deny the aforesaid averment.

That being so, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, the petition is allowed, and the order dated 15.06.2022, is made absolute on the same terms and conditions.
