By way of present petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, petitioners are seeking issuance of direction to respondents No.2 to 4 to protect their life and liberty at the hands of respondents No.5 to 12.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Sukhbeer Singh, Asstt.AG, Punjab, appears and accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

Ms. Manjot Kaur, Advocate, appears and accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.7 and 8.

As per petitioners, they have married on 08.06.2022 against the wishes of respondents No.5 to 12, who happen to be the relatives of petitioners.

Both the petitioners have claimed themselves to be major relying upon their Aadhar cards indicating that petitioner No.1-Gurmeto Devi is born on 18.07.2003 and petitioner No.2-Dharam Singh is born on 12.09.1991. Without commenting on the legality and validity of the

marriage, I deem it appropriate to direct respondent No.2 to consider the representation dated 08.06.2022 (Annexure P-6) filed by the petitioners.

Keeping in view the fact that both the petitioners claim to have married, I think that if possible, respondent No.2 may call a meeting of the petitioners as well as respondents No.5 to 12 in his presence, so that the parties get rid off their ill feelings and live amicably.

The petition stands disposed off.
