The prayer under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0065 dated 26.05.2022 under Sections 379, 420, 336, 285 and 34 IPC 1860, read with Section 7 of Essential Commodities Act, 1955, Sections 4 and 5 of Explosive Substances Act, 1908 and Section 23 of Petroleum Act, 1934 (Sections 411 and 120-B IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Sadar, District Sangrur.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 13.06.2022 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 13.06.2022 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 13.06.2022 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. Petition stands disposed of.
