Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in criminal case having FIR No.45 dated 06.05.2022 registered under Sections 457 & 380 of IPC at Police Station Meharban, District Ludhiana.

In the present case initially DDR was registered against unknown persons for committing theft of goods from the go-down of complainant and thereafter FIR was registered against both the petitioners on the basis of further statement of the complainant.

The counsel for the petitioners apprised the Court that the petitioners have joined the investigation with the police in compliance of the previous order of interim bail.

The State counsel on instructions from ASI Radhe Sham has not refuted the aforesaid assertions made by the counsel for the petitioners and further submits that now the petitioners are not required by the police for any further investigation or custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 14.06.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
