The petitioner has approached this Court praying for grant of regular bail in a case FIR No.27 dated 9.4.2021, registered under Section 366, 366-A, 363, 376(3), 506 IPC and 6 of POCSO Act, at Women Police Station, Bhiwani, District Bhiwani.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner fairly submits that he may be allowed to withdraw the present petition. He submits that as the petitioner is behind bars since 25.5.2021, the trial Court be directed to expedite the trial.

Learned State counsel has submitted that out of total 20 prosecution witnesses, 17 witnesses already stands examined.

The Court finds the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner is genuine.

Dismissed as withdrawn. The trial Court is requested to expedite the trial and conclude the same preferably within four months.
